ABOUT THE COLLEGE



Khandra College, a co-educational institution imparting higher education, is located at Khandra, Dist. Paschim Bardhaman, West Bengal (Lat-23° 06' 33'' N & Long-87° 22' 0'' E). The college was established in 1981 under the leadership of the late Amalendu Bakshi, a local Philanthrope, to cater higher education among the boys and girls of the surrounding area. 

ABOUT THE COLLEGE



Khandra College, a co-educational institution imparting higher education, is located at Khandra, Dist. Paschim Bardhaman, West Bengal (Lat-23° 06' 33'' N & Long-87° 22' 0'' E). The college was established in 1981 under the leadership of the late Amalendu Bakshi, a local Philanthrope, to cater higher education among the boys and girls of the surrounding area. The primary motto of the college was to set up a minimum infrastructure for imparting higher education to young students who were mostly first-generation learners coming from economically backward strata of the society.
