

### **OVERARCHING THEME** **“Mainstreaming Gender: A Roadmap to a Sustainable Tomorrow”**

Gender Equality is one of the major building blocks for a sustainable world. The idea of gender equality emphasizes on promoting equal rights, opportunities and treatment for all individuals in the society irrespective of their gender. Gender inequality is a historical hurdle encompassing lack of social justice faced by the women and girls in the entire globe. It attracts major attention of the policymakers in both advanced and underdeveloped nations. Gender mainstreaming is a strategy to minister and cement various perspectives of gender equality into policy formulation and its implementation.

United Nations has made consecutive attempts on the issue of gender equality in its various assemblies overtime. In 1948, UN General Assembly had included gender equality as a major part of international human rights law. The General Assembly had organized its first World Conference on Women in 1975. In the year 1979, the UN General Assembly had formulated the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW), also defined as an International Bill of Rights for Women. The Convention aims on reducing the unevenness existing in all forms of gender discrimination including culture and tradition. Recently, United Nations is emphasizing on its sustainable development goals (SDGs), where women play an important role in affirming such targets. Goal 5 of the SDGs highlights on achieving gender equality and empowering all women and girls around the

globe. Thus it aims in narrowing the various and multi-faceted gender gaps that exist in the society.


