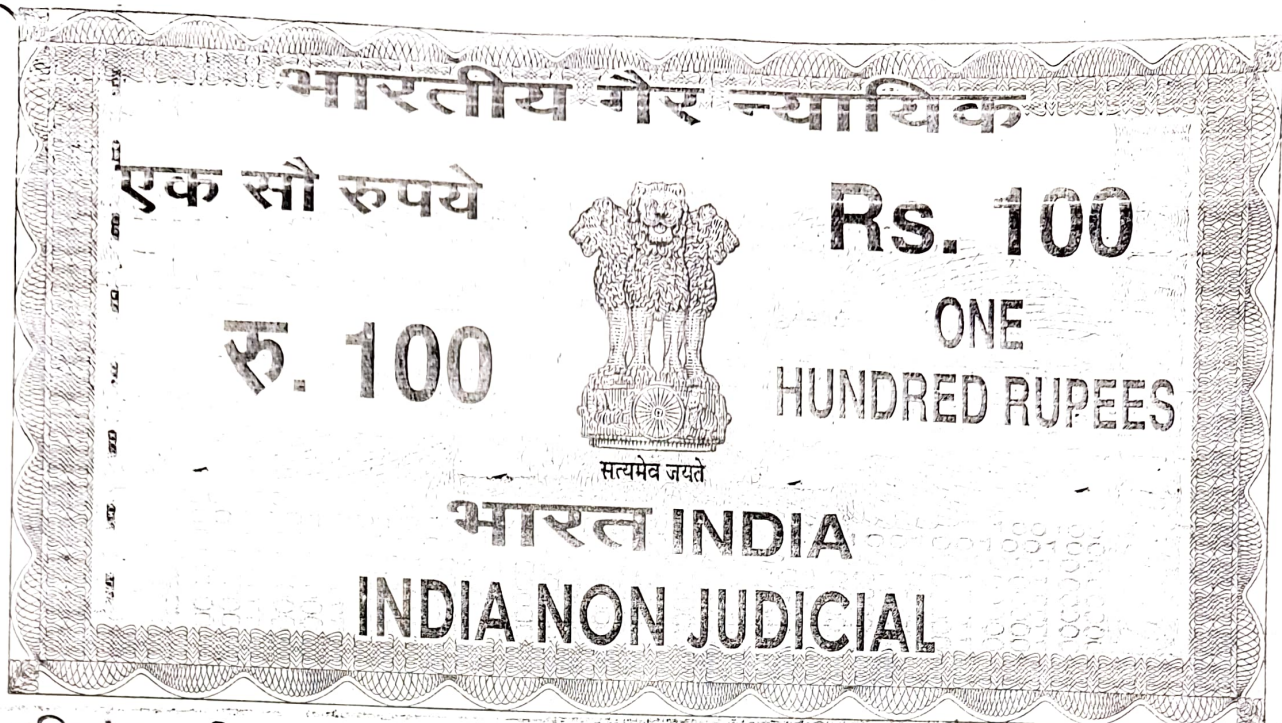

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Between

'Learnnet Skills Limited' & 'Khandra College, Khandra, Paschim Bardhaman'

For

'Delivery of Short-Term Skills Training Programs' undergraduate
Employability Enhancement Training Initiative (GEET)

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") dated 4th Dec' 2024

BETWEEN

Learnnet Skills Limited (Learnnet Skills), as **First Party**, a company incorporated in India and having its Office located at "D-114, Pocket C, Okhla I, Okhla Industrial Area, New Delhi, Delhi 110020". Learnnet Skills is a joint initiative of SCHOOLNET INDIA LTD and National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC). Learnnet Skills has been implementing various skill development programs with support from various ministries/departments of central and state governments, corporate and other institutions.

AND

Khandra College, Khandra, Paschim Bardhaman, Pin-713363



Learnnet Skills & Khandra College, are individually referred to as '1st Party' and collectively referred to as '2nd Parties'.

1. Terms of the MoU:

Learnnet Skills and Khandra College intend to work together for a period of 3 years from the date of execution of the MoU. However, the tenure shall be subject to renewal for successive annual terms, as may be mutually agreed, in writing by both parties, unless/upon otherwise terminated in accordance with the provisions of this MOU.

2. Short Term Skills Training Program Details:

3. Commercial: Training Program

Learnnet Skills has mobilized the fund to support this initiative for the current year under its CSR business, however as we advance the commercial shall be mutually decided and a separate Addendum to this MoU shall be signed for the commercial terms which would be treated as part of this MoU.

4. Roles and Responsibilities of Learnnet Skills

1. Candidates orientation and counselling
2. Career Readiness Test to shortlist candidates
3. Batch formation
4. Identification and deployment of trainers
5. Administering the training program
6. Conducting placement drives
7. To provide the training content (Session Plan, Participant Handbook etc.)
8. Deploy qualified trainers for delivery of the training program/s
9. Install necessary brandings inside the training facility.
10. Provide training consumable, as required for the training.
11. Conduct assessments (formative & summative)
12. Issue Learnnet 'Course Completion Certificates' to successful trainees

5. Roles and Responsibilities of Khandra College

- (1) Provide training infrastructure to run the classes (Classroom, Computer lab, Internet, Electricity, Drinking water, Washrooms, Counselling room etc)
- (2) Mobilization of candidates for training from Alumni database
- (3) Facilitating placement drive (Interview room, employer room etc)

- (4) Ensuring candidates attendance, information circulation through college outreach channel.
- (5) Facilitating trainers' identification

6. **Confidentiality & non-disclosure**

- (a) Both parties shall severally take all necessary care to ensure that the information provided by the other party remains confidential and further agree not to use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than the purpose for which they are intended. "Khandra College" and "LEARNET SKILLS", shall disclose any Confidential Information to anyone other than the employees of either organization who have a need to know the Confidential Information and/or the statutory authorities. The obligation of the confidentiality shall subsist until the expiration or sooner determination of this MoU.
- (b) Upon the cessation of this MoU either by termination by the parties or by efflux of time either party shall deliver to the other all documents, plans, drawings, sources, electronic media or any other source or papers in any way relating to the affairs of each other, which may be in its possession or under its control.

7. **Indemnification:**

The parties shall indemnify each other and hold each other harmless against any and all direct damages arising from any act or omission pertaining to their obligation under this MoU.

8. **Modification:**

This MoU may be modified, through a written document signed by duly authorized representatives of both parties.

9. **Termination:**

- (a) **Termination:** Either party may terminate this MoU upon 30 (Thirty days) calendar days notice in writing to the other party. However, any outstanding projects shall be completed to the satisfaction of the clients unless it is mutually agreed otherwise.

10. **Compliance with laws:**

"Khandra College" and "LEARNET SKILLS", shall at all times and at its own expense will strictly comply with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, data protection compliances, and Governmental orders and maintain in full force and effect all licenses, permits, authorization, registration and qualifications from all Governmental departments and agencies to the extent necessary to perform its obligations here under.

11. **Dispute resolution:**



- (a) This MoU shall be governed according to the laws of India, and each Party shall submit to the jurisdiction of the Courts at New Delhi, India.
- (b) Any and all differences and disputes whatsoever arising between the parties shall in the first instance be resolved mutually between the parties and in the event of a non-resolution the matter may be referred to arbitration.
- (c) Both the parties shall mutually appoint one arbitrator and any decision, determination or award of the Arbitrator shall be binding on the parties. The cost of arbitration shall be shared by the parties in equal proportion & the venue of arbitration shall be New Delhi, India.

12. General Provisions:

- (a) No waiver:

The failure of either party to assert any of its rights under this MoU shall not be deemed to constitute a waiver of that party's right thereafter to enforce each and every provision of this MoU in accordance with its terms.

- (b) Notice:

All notices required or permitted by, or made pursuant to this MoU shall be in writing and shall be sent by facsimile or by registered, first class airmail, return receipt requested and postage prepaid, to the following addresses:

All such notices shall be deemed to have been received as follows:

- (i) If by facsimile, twenty-four(24) hours after transmission, and
- (ii) if by registered, first class airmail, upon receipt of acknowledgement of delivery

- (c) Force Majeure

Neither party here to shall be considered in breach hereof or in default if it fails to perform or observe any or all the terms of this MoU resulting directly or indirectly, such as, but not limited to acts of God, Civil or Military authority, acts of Government, acts of Public Enemy, war, riots, explosion, earthquake, flood, storm, lightning strike, etc. In such a case either party shall notify the other party of the occurrence of such cause and should as a consequence, the performance under this MoU be prevented for a period longer than six months, then the other party shall have the right to terminate this MoU



13. Severability:

If any of the provisions of this MoU are declared to be invalid, such provisions shall be severed from this MoU and the other provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.





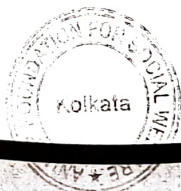

Such events may include, but are not limited to, acts of God, natural disasters (e.g., earthquakes, floods, hurricanes), war, terrorism, civil unrest, strikes, lockouts, epidemics, pandemics, governmental actions or regulations, or any other event or circumstance that could not have been avoided or mitigated with reasonable care.

14.2 Notification

In the event of a Force Majeure occurrence, the affected party shall promptly notify the other party in writing of the occurrence of such an event, the nature of the Force Majeure, and its estimated duration. The affected party shall use all reasonable efforts to mitigate the effects of the Force Majeure and resume performance of their obligations as soon as possible.

14.3 Suspension of Obligations

During the period of Force Majeure, the obligations of the affected party under this MoU shall be suspended to the extent they are affected by the Force Majeure event. The affected party shall not be liable for any delay or failure in the performance of its obligations to the extent caused by the Force Majeure.

14.4 Termination due to Force Majeure event

If a Force Majeure event continues for a period exceeding [Number] days, either party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice to the other party. In such a case, any outstanding obligations or payments that have accrued up to the date of termination shall be settled as per the terms of this MoU.

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14.5 No Compensation

Neither party shall be liable to the other for any direct or indirect loss, damage, or cost resulting from the occurrence of a Force Majeure event.

ARTICLE 15 **GOVERNING LAW:**

This MoU is made under and shall be governed by and constructed under the law of the republic of India under the jurisdiction of the court at Kolkata.

ARTICLE 16 **AMENDMENTS**

This MoU shall not be amended, changed, modified in whole or in part except by an instrument in writing signed by both the Parties hereto. However, Anudip Foundation reserves the right to modify scope of the Program on its sole discretion on notification to Partner Institute.

ARTICLE 17 **DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

In the event of any claim, Controversy, Dispute or differences between the parties arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this agreement either party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with rules of arbitrators, one to be appointed by Anudip Foundation, the other to be appointed by KHANDRA COLLEGE and the third party to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the parties. The place of arbitration shall be Kolkata. The Language of Arbitration Proceedings shall be English. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the parties.

ARTICLE 18 **COUNTERPARTS:**

This MoU may be executed in two counterparts each of which when so executed and delivered in the English language shall be an original, but all of which shall together constitute one and same instrument.
